Information relating to personal data processing

Vattenfall AB/BUND* and AB SVAFO are responsible for the processing of personal data. The General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) requires a legal basis for such processing. In addition, the company is required to provide information about how personal data is processed and its purpose.
