

Information to Vattenfall's / SVAFO:s suppliers in light of the corona virus outbreak

In order to limit the spread of the Covid-19 (corona) virus, Vattenfall has updated its Group Directives, applicable to Vattenfall's employees, inhouse consultants, as well as suppliers and visitors at all Vattenfall plants, projects and premises. This includes SVAFO.

Vattenfall is now stepping up the efforts to minimize the consequences of the outbreak of the Covid-19 "corona" virus outbreak. Therefore, we are now taking measures that are in line with what is being implemented across the industry.

This includes travel restrictions for all international business travels as well as 14 days of home-working for employees returning from most affected countries, see current list below (information might be updated). Participation to external events and meetings are restricted to business critical and only within Vattenfall's core countries.

External visitors, contractors and consultants

- External visitors coming to Vattenfall premises that have been travelling in any of the most affected countries for the last 14 days are not allowed on Vattenfall premises. It is responsibility of the meeting organizer to communicate this information to external visitors before bringing them into Vattenfall premises.
- Affected individuals (under the 14 days quarantine) should be replaced by temporary resources to ensure compliance
- Meetings with external visitors via conference call are encouraged whenever possible.
